

Prospect Youth Soccer Association Scholarship

The Prospect Youth Soccer Association will award two \$2,000 scholarships. The scholarships are dedicated to Tony Moutinho and Bob Rosa. Tony Moutinho is currently the head coach of the Woodland Regional High School Boys soccer team, and has spent many hours educating coaches and training players for the soccer association. Bob Rosa has coached soccer within the league for many years, served on the Board as Referee Coordinator from November 2004 to November 2007, and currently assists in maintaining the Prospect Soccer web site.

2010 Scholarship Guidelines

The scholarships will be awarded to Prospect or Beacon Falls residents who are graduating seniors at a local public or private high school. The scholarships will be awarded contingent upon successful full time enrollment in a two- or four- year accredited collage or technical program.

Criteria for Selection

1. Must be a Prospect or Beacon Falls resident.
2. Must be a current or past participant in the Prospect Youth Soccer Program.
3. Must maintain a grade point average of 75 or higher.
4. Must complete the attached application.
5. Must provide a transcript.
6. Must write an essay with a minimum of 300 words typed and double-spaced on:
How My Soccer Experience Enhanced My Future.
